



ART 267: Publication Design

Students learn the fundamentals of designing publications, focusing on typographic systems and the hierarchy of information and using a grid for multi-page documents. The course introduces electronic page-layout using industry-standard page-software such as InDesign. Students acquire the basic skills and knowledge to design multi-page documents through lectures and hands-on exercises and projects. Pre or co-requisite: ART 260 and ART 266, or permission of the instructor or program coordinator. Three hours critique and three hours studio per week. Instructional Support Fee applies. Gen. Ed.
