



ESL 122: Advanced English Grammar Review

This course is designed to foster mastery of advanced structures of the English language, in both written and spoken form. As part of the final evaluation of this course, students will demonstrate proficiency on a cumulative final exam. Prerequisite: ESL 012 with a C- or better or permission of the instructor, or test score of 81/120. Three lecture hours per week. Instructional Support Fee applies. 3 credits Fall, Spring

Course Student Learning Outcomes

1. Identify and demonstrate use of the following grammar structures with 70% mastery, verb tenses, including perfect tenses, subject/verb agreement, count and non-count nouns with qualifiers, modals, complex sentences with noun, adjective, and adverb clauses, gerunds and infinitives, connectives, including conjunctions and transitions.
2. Demonstrate competency in applying these structures in oral language use.
3. Demonstrate ability to incorporate these structures in written assignments.
